LOCAL RULES

1 Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- Beyond any fence, ditch, hedge or line of white stakes defining the boundary of the course.
- On or beyond any white line defining the boundary of the course.

2 Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

Red penalty areas are defined by red stakes or red lines. When both stakes and lines are used, the edge of the penalty area is defined by the outside edge of the line and the stakes show where the penalty area is.

Note: The part of a bridge that crosses a penalty area is in the penalty area.

3 Abnormal Course Conditions, including Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16)

3.1 Ground Under Repair

- Any area bounded by a white line.
- The flower bed by the 14th tee.
- Tractor or buggy wheel marks.

3.2 Immovable Obstructions

- All artificially surfaced roads and paths on the course, including those covered with wood chips. Individual pieces of woodchip are loose impediments.
- Fairway yardage discs

3.3 Embedded Ball (Staked Bunker Faces)

Rule 16.3 is modified in this way: Free relief is not allowed when a ball is embedded in stacked turf or soil faces above bunkers.

4 Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens (e.g. Sprinkler Heads)

In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an

immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

(Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable)

5 No Play Zones

- Young trees identified by wrapping, stakes or otherwise protected are no play zones:
 - If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.
 - If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player must take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rule 17.1e(2).
- Any area bounded by a blue line.

6 Integral Objects

Buildings on the course are integral objects, from which free relief is not available.

7 Aeration Holes

- If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole:
- Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. If the ball comes to rest in another aeration hole the player may take relief again under this Local Rule.
 - Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d. But interference does not exist if the aeration hole only interferes with the player's stance or, on the putting green, on the player's line of play.

Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the General Penalty
