## Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023

#### **General Managers Report: Theresa Plimmer**

Theresa reported that the greenkeepers have been fighting the recent heavy rainfall around the course. The average rainfall in September is approximately 34mm and this year it had been 132mm plus it had rained for almost all of the first two weeks of October. Greens maintenance has been pulled forward to week commencing 6<sup>th</sup> November as it will help firm up the greens after which verti draining will be carried out as the verti drain machine has now been repaired and returned into service.

Going forward the ropes will soon be out around the greens for the winter period and buggies will only be available weather dependant.

A decision has been made not to make hedgehog wheels compulsory throughout the winter for the foreseeable future.

A discussion took place around when it was the right time to move the tees forward and general consensus was that it should be reviewed weekly with the greenkeepers.

# **Treasurers Report: Hans Bauder**

Hans had already issued the accounts to Mark Northern and Martin Bettison for verification and all are accepted as a true reflection of the account. The account is in a positive position but will drop into a negative balance with forthcoming subsidised events such as Presentation Evening and Turkey Trot. Hans also reported that the charity fund was in an excellent position and the amount will be revealed at the Presentation Evening when cheques will be issued to the two charities.

John White informed all that members of the charity committee, Danny Harkin, Theresa Plimmer and Sachin Kanaiya would be discussing the charity fund raising and how well it has done over the past years on Sports Scene radio presentation on Radio Nottingham on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

# **Competitions Report: John White**

John answered that they would look at putting a some on going forward. Mark Northern presented a letter from a 5 day senior member regarding the speed of play during competitions.

The committee decided that as it relates to senior weekday competitions that speed of play should be monitored/regulated by the organisers of said competitions and as such the letter was passed to Richard Hine to process.

## Handicap Report: Mark Northern

Mark reported that all handicaps are up to date.

A discussion took place about when the tees are moved forward and when to remove general play scores from the system and it was agreed to leave the general play entries open until the weather conditions are no longer suitable.

#### Junior Section Update: Dene Parsons

Dene stated that he and Jack were looking at running free lessons in the winter.

Dene informed all that currently we have approximately 10 juniors with qualifying handicaps and a number keen to progress so things have improved slightly on last years numbers.

## **Discipline: Mark Northern on behalf of John Hilton**

There are currently 2 fines outstanding of which 1 has agreed to pay but has not been in attendance to do so recently.

John White raised the current fines and disciplinary process and offered a suggestion for consideration to be discussed further and implemented at the AGM.

## Any Other Business

Sachin informed all that as the Gedling Challenge had been cancelled this year that there would be two events next year with the first booked for 14<sup>th</sup> April 2024 and the second date will be arranged for July 2024 with the exact date to be confirmed.

A further discussion around how best to run Club Championships over the two days next year to avoid the 5-6 hour rounds at the end of the competition on day 2. All were asked to consider the options presented and finalise at the next meeting.

Phil Abbott stated that he had been talking to some new members and said that they would mlike to see more drawn competitions.

A discussion took place around the pros and cons of introducing more drawn competitions and it was decided that at this time if anyone wants to play with different people they have the option of randomly entering any open slot. Also to run drawn competitions in the past caused a lot of upset when certain members had been left on their own when others either pulled out or moved groups on the tee on the day which caused various problems for Brian the starter.

It was discussed that a lot of new members do not know the rule s and it would be a good idea to include some rules in the centre newsletter that Theresa produces and also occasionally on the web site.
